Being a member of the Rotary Organization provides you with a valuable connection to community leaders who care about issues facing our community. As a Rotarian you will have the opportunity to learn more and develop professional skills. Rotary creates a more positive environment for promoting worlds understanding and peace.

- 1. **Friendship:** In an increasingly complex world, Rotary provides one of the most basic human needs the need for friends and fellowship.
- 2. **Personal Growth and Development:** Membership in Rotary continues one's growth in human relations and personal development. - Attend a meeting or Rotary event and decide if the organization is one that you would like to be part of. Note: First attendance at a meeting/event is paid for by the club. All subsequent meetings and/or events attended remain your sole responsibility to pay (weekly meeting fee is \$16, event's as priced).
- 2) Complete the membership application and furnish both a personal and business reference.
- 3) Submit your application with your check in the amount of \$50.00 made payable to the Rotary Club of Schenectady.
- 4) During the application process, you are encouraged to continue to attend the weekly meetings. This provides you the opportunity to further engage with our members and shows a commitment to the organization and your availability to attend our weekly meetings.
- 5) Your application will be reviewed by the Membership Committee, a member of which will also contact your references.
- 6) Once your application has been approved by Membership, it will be submitted to the Board for approval. Note: The board meets on the second Wednesday of every month.
- 7) Once the Board has approved your application, you will be notified and asked to appear at a meeting for induction into the Rotary Club of Schenectady.
- 8) Once inducted as a member of the Rotary Club of Schenectady, you will receive a name badge which will contain a green dot. This green dot signifies you as a new member and you will be required to complete all the green dot requirements (see Green Dot Removal Process) and once those are complete. A Green Dot removal ceremony will be held and you will receive a membership pin.
