The Rotary Club of Schenectady is pleased to announce this year's scholarship contest. The 2025 award is \$1,500. The winner is expected to join a Thursday Rotary meeting in-person.

Scholarships are awarded based on the following criteria:

- Applicants must reside in or attend High School in the City of Schenectady.
- Applicants must be officially accepted into an accredited degree program at a community
 college or university that will result in an Associates, Bachelor's degree, or be officially
 accepted into an accredited certificate program at a school or training facility.
- Applicants must demonstrate clear career plans and a scheduled time frame in which you expect to achieve your educational goals.
- Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0.

Note – The scholarships will be awarded on the basis of merit; however financial need will be taken into consideration when all other factors are equal among applicants.

The deadline to submit applications is May 1, 2025. Submit ONE original and a digital copy of the original application.
