Summary

This small project has made it possible to serve 218 families, including 155 in Carrefour, a commune in the West Department of Haiti, and 63 in Camp-Perrin, a commune in the south of Haiti. These 218 families number about 1,526 people considering an average of 7 people per family. Thanks to this project, the 1,526 members of these 218 families now have access to safe drinking water for a period of approximately five (5) years. This type of initiative is of paramount importance for populations living in overcrowded conditions in disadvantaged areas and who do not have sufficient economic means to obtain drinking water on a daily basis to meet their basic needs. This project will help save many lives by helping beneficiaries prevent some serious, sometimes fatal, diseases caused by various bacteria and other pathogens present in contaminated water.

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1.- Context

Access to safe drinking water remains a major challenge for many communities in Haiti, particularly in the communes of Carrefour and Camp-Perrin. Drinking unfiltered water exposes families to significant health risks, including waterborne diseases such as diarrhea, cholera, and other intestinal infections. In this context, the water filter distribution project was designed to address an urgent need to provide sustainable access to safe drinking water and to improve the living conditions of vulnerable populations.

The justification for this project is based on the importance of strengthening the autonomy of the beneficiaries in the management of their daily water. By providing water filters with hands-on training on their use and maintenance, the project aims to reduce health risks, raise awareness of good hygiene practices and promote sustainable change in their daily lives. This project contributes to local public health and is in line with the objectives of the Rotary Club of Schenectady and the Rotary Club of Camp-Perrin in terms of community support and sustainable development.

This report is part of the implementation of this mini-project for the distribution of two hundred and eighteen (218) water filters in the communes of Carrefour (locality Matogou) and Camp-Perrin. This project is funded by the Rotary Club of Schenectady, whose objective is to provide 218 families with access to drinking water and thus improve their living conditions and health.

2- Project implementation

The Rotary Club of Camp-Perrin team distributed these water filters in four (4) different areas, including two in each of the chosen municipalities. This initiative has enabled several vulnerable families in the targeted areas to benefit from a drinking water filtration system and to see its importance in their daily lives. At Carrefour, this activity was carried out by the GOGESMA team, under the direction of its main leader, Jhonny Honoré, and under the supervision of the Rotary Club of Camp-Perrin and in Camp-Perrin by the Rotary Club directly.

2.1.- Choice of beneficiaries

The selection of beneficiaries was carefully carried out in order to target the most vulnerable families and those in real need of access to drinking water. Specific criteria have been established to guide this choice, taking into account in particular the socio-economic situation of households and their ability to use and maintain the water filter correctly. This approach ensured that aid actually reached the most needy populations in the areas of intervention.

2.2.- Purchase of equipment

As part of the implementation of the project, all equipment procurement operations were carried out according to planned and transparent procedures. This mainly concerned the acquisition of water filters as well as the logistical equipment necessary for their transport and distribution. Purchases were made with product quality, durability and cost in mind to ensure the effectiveness and sustainability of the project.

2.3.- Training of beneficiaries

As part of the implementation of the project, two training sessions were organized for the benefit of the participants in order to strengthen their knowledge and practices in terms of access to drinking water and hygiene.

1. Water hygiene training

This session, led by doctors, aimed to raise awareness among beneficiaries about the importance of using safe water for the protection of health and the improvement of the well-being of communities. During this training, participants were informed about good practices related to the collection, treatment, transport and conservation of water in order to prevent the risk of contamination. Essential concepts were also covered, including regular hand washing, the use of clean and well-covered containers, and the proper maintenance of filters and other water treatment devices. This training helped to strengthen the knowledge of the beneficiaries and to promote the adoption of behaviours conducive to better hygiene within households and the community.

2. Training on the operation and use of water filters

The second session was led by the members of the GOGESMA committee and the Rotary Club of Camp-Perrin who were formed by MAGEPA (Fritz Pierre Louis) It mainly focused on the operation, proper use and maintenance of the water filters distributed within the framework of the project. This training allowed the beneficiaries to better understand the principle of the filtration system and its importance for access to quality drinking water. Practical demonstrations were carried out to illustrate the different steps of using the filter. The trainers and club members also consumed the filtered water in the presence of the participants, which helped to strengthen the beneficiaries' confidence in the effectiveness of the device and encourage its correct and sustainable use in their daily lives.

2.4.- Distribution of filters and signature of the acceptance form

The distribution of the water filters was carried out with rigorous organization to ensure that each selected family received its equipment in good conditions. The activities were planned in advance, with the coordination of the Rotary Club of Camp-Perrin team and the support of the members present at each site.

All beneficiaries have signed a common form attesting to the receipt of the filters and their accessories, thus guaranteeing traceability and good management of resources. The full list of beneficiaries, including their contact details and signatures, is annexed to this report, ensuring transparency and traceability of the entire distribution. These measures strengthen the credibility of the project and make it possible to monitor the impact with the beneficiary communities. The table below shows the sites, dates and number of water filters distributed and the signed lists are in the appendix to this document.

2.5.- Visual aids

In order to illustrate the progress of the various activities carried out within the framework of this project, a series of photos is presented in the appendix of this report. In addition to the photos presented in the appendix, videos were also made to document the different stages of the activity, including the training sessions, the water filtration demonstrations and the distribution of the filters to the beneficiaries. These videos are available in digital formats and complement the information presented in this report. The Rotary Club of Camp-Perrin can submit them if necessary.

2.6- Expenses incurred

As part of the implementation of this mini-project, several expenses have been incurred to ensure the proper organization and smooth running of the various activities. The price of the transport which was ($218 \times 2.46 = \$ 536.28$) has been modified in order to respond to certain unforeseen events (such as printing of stickers to put on the bokits to allow the visibility of the Rotary, transport costs for the 3 members of the GOGESMA committee during their training at the MAGEPA premises and the rest was intended for the transport of tripods which were located far from the distribution site). All of these expenses were carried out in accordance with the objectives of the project and with a view to transparency and good management of the resources made available. The table below presents in detail the various expenses incurred as part of this project.

All expenses incurred in carrying out this project were supported by appropriate supporting documentation, except for transportation where the drivers did not have a means to provide a receipt. The invoices corresponding to the various expenses incurred are annexed to this report in order to ensure transparency and traceability in the use of the funds.

3.- Conclusion

This mini-project for the distribution of water filters has improved access to drinking water for several vulnerable families in the municipalities of Carrefour and Camp-Perrin. Thanks to the support of the Rotary Club of Schenectady and the commitment of the members of the Rotary Club of Camp-Perrin, the training and distribution activities took place in good conditions and in accordance with established principles. Beneficiaries now have an effective way to filter water and reduce the risks associated with the consumption of non-potable water. This project is therefore an important contribution to improving the living and health conditions of the beneficiary communities.

N.B: This mini-project can in no way replace the Global Grant that the Rotary Club of Schenectady has tried for several years to carry out in the community of Matogou but it testifies to the effort, honesty, goodwill and sincerity of respecting its commitments despite the many obstacles and difficulties encountered in Haiti. I regret to see in each distribution site the dissatisfaction, the desolation on the faces of people who wanted to provide a water filtering system as well, but the quantity available was significantly lower than demand.

Let us hope that Haiti will soon regain its peace and that local and international organizations will be able to intervene freely.
